Want to empower your community and mobilize Asian and Pacific American voters for Election Day (Nov. 4, 2014)? Apply to become a volunteer.

Requirements

1. Must be a high school or college student.
2. No experience needed. Training will be provided.
3. Must have access to commute vehicle (self-drive or parent drop-off is acceptable.)
4. All volunteers must sign a waiver before participating in any activities. If you are under 18 years of age, a parent/guardian must sign for approval.

Register voters in your neighborhood, at your school, local grocery store, community events, or public library!



High school students may be eligible for community service hours, with a minimum of 20 hours of volunteering.

All student volunteers may receive a letter of recommendation for their participation.

Student volunteers registering more than 10 voters will receive a Certificate of Recognition from California Secretary of State Debra Bowen.

SPECIAL Honor will be given to student(s) who registers at least 30 voters and has the most registered voters. The student(s) will join dinner with Secretary of State Ms. Debra Bowen and have a picture with her.
